CURRICULUM

Gerald McShane School is in its 1st year of implementation of the French Immersion Program in Kindergarten and Grade 1. The program will be implemented in Grade 2 in 2011-2012.

In math and science, our students are challenged to reach their full potential. Activities such as our Science Fair allow students to express their passion and interests for the sciences.

Through our school-wide literacy projects, students are required to write in both English and French using different genres of writing.

We have a huge gymnasium where exciting and well-developed physical education classes take place. We have a certified skating program with Skate Canada coaches to teach the students. In addition to their physical education program, our Kindergarten students follow a program sponsored by Québec en Forme to help develop their gross motor skills.

ART PROGRAMS

Through our music program, the students have the opportunity to learn a variety of instruments. The cycles II and III students learn to play the recorder. Our state of the art recording equipment allows us to record both our students' instrumental and vocal talents.

Our art room allows the students to express themselves through diverse artistic mediums and techniques. Classes and groups of students have been involved in mural projects that are permanently exposed at the community's cultural centre and in the school itself.
